CLASS SIZES–PUPIL/TEACHER RATIOS 2023-2024

As required by § 22.1-253.13:2(M) of the Code of Virginia, school divisions shall report to the public the actual teacher/pupil ratios in schools for the current school year. This section of the Code of Virginia states that “actual pupil/teacher ratios shall include only the teachers who teach the grade and class on a full-time basis and shall exclude resource personnel.” Another requirement of § 22.1-253.13:2(M) is that school boards report pupil/teacher ratios that include resource teachers.

Included in the chart below are the average class sizes and average pupil/teacher ratios for grades K-3 and grades 4-5 for each elementary school. A chart for the average pupil/teacher ratio for grades 6, 7 and 8 for each middle school and grades 9-12 for each high school in the Pittsylvania County School Division is available on the next page.
